Let's get Splatting!


1. Click on the green play button.




2. Select Student.




3. If this is your first time, create a new profile.



4. Select a character image and click continue.




5. Click on the box and type a username.




You've created a new profile, and are ready to start coding with Splats!

Coding Time!

This is your coding screen. See the coding blocks by clicking on the categories on the left side of the screen. Drag blocks that you need on to the grid.




Once you have your blocks on the grid, right-click or long press to bring up a helpful menu. (Duplicate is the best!!)



Virtual Splats

The Splats on the left side of the screen work just like real, physical Splats. They are super helpful to test your code – they sense when they are pressed or released. Change the number of virtual Splats available by clicking the numbers in the top left.




Sharing Projects


First, open the User Tray and select “Save My Project.”
Click on the Export button.



You will see a “Save As” box open, with an option at the left to save to your Google Drive account. Select Google Drive – My Drive, and choose a file name, leaving the .txt!



You'll get a notification that your file was saved! If you click “Go to folder” you can make sure that it saved to your Google Drive.



Importing Projects

To import a project, go to “Create/Import a Project” in the User Tray and click on the “Import My Project” Button. Choose Google Drive – My Drive, and select your file.



The imported blocks will appear on your coding screen!
If you need to clear your screen, try the “clear all” button at the bottom of the User Tray.
